EYE SCREENING CAMP

Free Eye screening camp conducted at MarwaBasti, Amdabad, Manihari on 17.02.2018. 59 cases were examined out of which 19 Cataract were selected for IOL implantation suitably later on .

FREE HEALTH CHECK UP CAMP

Free Health Check up camp was conducted by Janlakshya at Marwa, Adivasi village, Amdabad, Manihari on 17.02.2018. Dr. P.C.Das, Dr. Raj Aman Singh and medical team of Janlakshya were present in the camp. Total 59 cases were examined followed by free blood test and Eye screening. Free medicines also given to the patients .

ENVIRONMENT CONSERVATION PROGRAMME :

Gogabil Lake is extensively spread over 218 acres of land. Migratory birds of different species fly over to this lake in the winter season every year. This adds to the aesthetic value of the lake substantially. Janlakshya is contemplated for conservation of this lake for proper protection of this lake. Janlakshya has engaged one guard since long for the gogabil area. Janlakshya is functioning relentlessly under the guidance of Mr. Arvind Mishra, Member of Bihar State Board for wild life & State co-ordinator of Indian Birds conservation.
