### RURAL UPLIFTMENT PROGRAMME

At Village - Chilmara, Katihar on 17.08.18 under dairy development project of NABARD In a meeting Mr. Amit Kumar, DDM, Mr.Santosh Kumar Singh , alongwith staffs of Janlakshya and beneficiaries were present. Mr. Amit Kumar addressed the beneficiaries emphasizing upon effective performance for substantial progress of the project and for clearance of dues outstanding at the earliest possible and also visited the project units physically.

### ENVIRONMENT CONSERVATION PROGRAMME :

On 23.12.2018, Janlakshya members and volunteers planted banyan and peepal plants in the vicinity of Gogabil lake to provide perching / resting place to migratory and resident birds as well as to add flora to the area which is devoid of it. The 8 - 10 feet mount, on which saplings were planted, were made by local residents of Marwa basti, an Adivasi village and maintained by the same people on remuneration basis.



## MARWA VILLAGE ADOPTED BY JANLAKSHYA

Janlakshya executive committee decided to adopt Adivasi populated Marwa Basti of Amdabad block on to look after its overall upliftment. Janlakshya team surveyed the village and helped the residents achieve electricity connection, latrines, Gas connection, Bank accounts, and other basic requirements within a span of about 9 month. As the village remains surrounded by water for 3 months during rains every year, Janlakshya donated a boat on 23.8.18 to the Adivasi community for their use during flood seasons and earn revenue by providing boat service to bird watchers and visitors.
